A GOOD LANDMARK IS THE POST OFFICE:

US POST OFFICE 300 N. New York Avenue Winter Park, FL 32789

COMING FROM I-4:

- 1. Exit onto Fairbanks Ave.
 - Turn East (toward Rollins College/downtown WP)
- 2. Turn LEFT onto 17-92 (ORLANDO AVE; traffic light; Walgreen's on far corner
- 3. Turn RIGHT onto MORSE BLVD; traffic light; Trader Joe's on left 4. Turn LEFT onto NEW YORK AVE; 4-way stop

In one block the Post Office will be on your RIGHT.

DO NOT PARK AT THE POST OFFICE!

However, a nearby, <u>quick</u>, SAFE, legal drop-off of passengers shouldn't be a problem. The driver can then find parking - various churches, clubs and private residences offer parking for a nominal fee. Parking garages are located behind the SunTrust Building on South Park Ave. near Fairbanks Ave. and behind Panera's on Canton Ave near North Park Ave. Several churches are located on Interlachen Ave. that runs parallel to New York Ave. on the other side (EAST) of the train tracks.

There are usually two lots on New York Ave. beyond the Post Office run by various nonprofits.

Return to meet passengers. The Schools Exhibit Information Tent is a good place to connect.

FOR TEACHERS (UNLOAD/LOAD):

After turning onto NEW YORK AVE, IMMEDIATELY on your RIGHT will be the "West Meadow" parking area for the artists.

Thursday any time and Friday morning only, we've arranged a few spots for teachers. If you are in the POST OFFICE parking lot, you missed the parking lot entrance by just a few feet; you will see the schools' tents on your RIGHT.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES for children, ages approx. 5-12

In the same area as the Schools Exhibit you will find:

- EASEL PAINTING, Sat/Sun, 10 am 3 pm
- HANDS-ON activities provided by local museums, Fri/Sat/Sun, 10 am 4 pm.

And, across the tracks, on the Centennial Stage, various live musical performances all weekend.
