EVENT SUMMARY

THE WINTER PARK SIDEWALK ART FESTIVAL (WPSAF): WPSAF is one of the nation's oldest and most prestigious juried fine art shows. It consistently ranks among the most highly regarded outdoor art shows in the nation. The show is conveniently located in Central Park, a beautifully landscaped area whose surrounding streets are closed during the festival to allow for foot traffic only. Artists' booths, schools' exhibits and the children's workshop village all nestle under large oak trees in the park. Attendance usually reaches 350,000 people for the three-day event which features free concerts in Central Park, a wide variety of food and beverages, children's easel painting, museum activities and Orange County schools' exhibits.

LEON THEODORE SCHOOLS EXHIBIT: WPSAF is committed to the arts and art education and has proudly showcased the student artwork and art programs of Orange County public and private schools since the first festival in 1960. The student displays are located in large tents near the Winter Park Post Office. The exhibit is named in honor of Leon Theodore, an acclaimed local artist, an Orange County Public Schools art teacher, and a former member and president of the art festival board. GENERAL INFORMATION (p 1 of 2)

PROHIBITED:

- **PAPER CLIPS** may be used only if completely removed from the panels and disposed of properly. The City Parks and Recreation Department requests that paper clips not be discarded into the grass. Imagine lawn mowers flinging metal bits and children playing and falling on such pieces.
- **STAPLES, NAILS and TACKS** may NOT be used in the tables.
- **LITTER:** Paper and tape must be removed from panels, tables, and the surrounding area then placed in the nearby trash receptacles at pick up.

PANELS:

- **SIZE:** ALL panels are wire metal screens, 37"x 72".
- **NUMBER & LAYOUTS:** Please see "Layouts" attached.
 - ELEMENTARY TOTAL: 2 sides (2 WIRE panels, one side of each.)
 - MIDDLE TOTAL: 6 sides (5 WIRE panels, one side of four; two sides of one.)
 - HIGH TOTAL: 10 sides (5 WIRE panels, two sides of each.)

NOTE: *The number of panels allocated to a few schools could vary. You will be notified well in advance if there is a change for your school.*
- **YOUR OWN PANELS:** You certainly may use your own display panels but they must be PRE-APPROVED. Please include a picture from the supplier's website or from one of your exhibits. You are asked and expected to adhere to the number of panels and space allotted to other schools when arranging your display. The panels, the footers and all the art work MUST be identified with your school's name.
- **MULTIPLE ART TEACHERS AT ONE SCHOOL:** If there are several art teachers at one school, the teachers will need to consolidate their students' works onto that school's allotted display panels.

TABLES: If your school has a 3-D art program and you would like a table for your exhibit, please indicate in the application. Tables will be provided only by request and as layout permits.

NOTE: *The use of staples in the tables is prohibited.*
Tables are 6' long. Up to 1 per MS; 2 per HS.

CERTIFICATES: Certificates of Achievement for each of your exhibiting students will be available when you check-in at the Schools Exhibit Information Tent. To facilitate your check-in, please send us the number of certificates you need for your school the week prior to the festival.

AWARDS: Awards will be given to 2D and 3D works at middle and high school levels. Our continued thanks are given to Art Systems of Central Florida (ASOF) who will again provide gift certificates to the four BOS winners.

DETAILS: Detailed information will be sent in February to each school's "Main Contact."

COMMENTS: Please feel free to share your suggestions and comments with us at any time. Your input is most helpful to us and all suggestions are carefully reviewed and considered.

GENERAL INFORMATION (p 2 of 2)

COMMITMENT: Submission of your school's completed Application to Participate is considered a firm commitment to exhibit your students' artwork and to abide by the Festival rules and regulations as established by the Festival Committee and the City of Winter Park.

PLEASE notify us immediately of CANCELLATIONS so another school may be given the opportunity to exhibit. **schools@wpsaf.org**.

APPLICATION: Your information is requested by **Sunday, October 3rd, 2021**. Spaces will be filled on a first-come basis dependent upon receipt of your completed application. It is in your best interests to return the requested information as quickly as possible to schools@wpsaf.org. Delays occur if not sent to this email address.

NOTE: Please return only **ONE (1)** application per school with **ALL** exhibiting art teachers listed and **ONE (1)** teacher designated to be your school's **MAIN CONTACT**. Application form is on page 5.

WAIT LIST: A Wait List will be created once all spaces are filled. Wait-listed schools will be notified of this status within a few days of receipt of their completed Application to Participate.

DATES: Please check your personal and school calendars before returning this commitment.

Setup: Thursday, March 17 - 2022; 8 am – 5 pm and
Friday, March 18, 2022, BEFORE 9 am

Pick up: Sunday, March 20, 2022; 3:30 – 4:00 pm

- *Avoid disappointed students, parents - let them know exhibits are removed Sunday at 3:30 pm!*
- **If you are not able to pick up your students' work in the specified time, please make alternative arrangements. WPSAF is not responsible for any work that is not picked up by 4:00 pm.**
- *Schools Exhibit must close earlier than the Festival due to high demands on the City's crews.*
- *Panels and tables are to be left in good condition without tape, paper, paper clips, or other attachments.*
- *The surrounding grounds should be cleared of all paper clips, binder clips, hooks, etc. Trash containers will be provided.*
