Kevin Abbott, specializing in midcentury New York school inspired paintings and sculpture works full time in Sanford, Fl and Bernhard's Bay, New York. His first fine art exhibition was in 1977 and he has exhibited photography, paintings, collage and sculpture ever since. His work has been included in well over 100 solo and group exhibitions in venues such as the Monterey Museum of Art in Monterey, California, The Southern Vermont Arts Center in Manchester, Vermont and the Everson Museum of Art in Syracuse, New York. Abbott's work has won numerous awards and he is the recipient of several grants including a 2008 Individual Artist's Grant from the New York State Council on the Art.

Belinda Glennon is an accomplished artist and educator, has been a ceramics instructor for Crealdé School of Art since 2002, and the Young Artist Program Manager for 10 years. In that capacity she has coordinated the on-site public-school field trips and managed programming across a variety of media including painting & drawing, photography, ceramics, sculpture, cartooning, and printmaking. The Seminole County Board of County Commissioners, in association with the Seminole Cultural Arts Council (SCAC), recognized Marla E as Seminole County's 2016 Artist of the Year.
